Welcome to Sackets Harbor

Sackets Harbor, a charming, historic community, nestled on the eastern shore of Lake Ontario, was settled in 1801 by Augustus Sacket. The village rose to prominence during the War of 1812, thanks to its strategic location.

Today, Sackets Harbor remains a vibrant lakeside community. Begin your visit at the Sackets Harbor Heritage Area Visitor Center, located in the original Augustus Sacket House on West Main Street, overlooking the harbor. The Visitor Center has an excellent orientation exhibit and video about the history and attractions in the area. From there, be sure to tour the sites related to the War of 1812 and our military history:

- Sackets Harbor Battlefield State Historic Site
- Pickering-Beach Museum
- Madison Barracks and Fort Pike
- Military Cemetery

In addition to our historic attractions, Sackets Harbor features a range of shops, galleries, restaurants, accommodations, and family-friendly attractions. Marinas, boat launches, docks, and nearby Westcott Beach, Southwick Beach, and Robert G. Wehle State Parks all provide a variety of outdoor and on-the-water activities.

Sackets Harbor also offers events all year round, which this year include the annual First Day Hike in January, the Total Solar Eclipse in April, Great Lakes Poetry in May and June, weekly Concerts on the Waterfront from June through early September, the Can-Am Festival and the Grand Tactical in July, the Brew York Festival in August, the Sackets Harbor Marathon and Half Marathon in September, the annual Quilt Show and HalloweenVille Festival in October, and the Yuletide Celebration in December.

It's a great starting point to explore the Thousand Islands region and to take advantage of Lake Ontario's many recreational opportunities, including boating, swimming, and some of the best fishing in the eastern United States.



A VILLAGE STEEPED IN HISTORY

Sackets Harbor played a pivotal role in our nation's history, as the site of two battles during the War of 1812





The Sackets Harbor Battlefield State Historic Site

If you enjoy American History, the Battlefield State Historic Site is a can't miss attraction! The site highlights the military heritage of Sackets Harbor from the War of 1812 through the 20th century.

Following the outbreak of war between the US and Great Britain in June 1812, Sackets Harbor became the center of American naval and military activity for the St. Lawrence Valley and Lake Ontario, with two Battles of Sackets Harbor fought here: the first in 1812 and the second in 1813.

Discover how Sackets Harbor evolved from a small wilderness settlement in 1801 into the thriving headquarters for the US Army,

Navy, and Marines' northern frontier by 1812. Explore the educational exhibits, interpretive signage, and guided and selfguided walks. Learn about Sackets Harbor's notable shipbuilding history by strolling through the restored 1850s Navy Yard and touring the Commandant's House.

Most importantly, you'll witness how the New York State site preserves our heritage, while also recognizing and honoring all the military personnel who fought and died in the War of 1812.

For those visiting on summer weekends, staff at the Battlefield dress in period clothing and recreate what life was like

for local villagers and military members. (Please check the Battlefield's website for a complete schedule of events.)

The Battlefield grounds are accessible from dawn to dusk year-round; however, the buildings and exhibits are open on a seasonal basis, from May through October.

July 27-28: The War of 1812 Grand Tactical

The Sackets Harbor Battlefield State Historic Site will host the War of 1812 North American Grand Tactical on Saturday, July 27, from 9 am to 9 pm, and Sunday, July 28, from 9 am to 3 pm.

The Grand Tactical is an annual gathering of hundreds of War of 1812 reenactors, historians, and authors, joined by numerous musicians, dancers, and living history specialists.


Grand Tacticals alternate annually between the US and Canada. Organizers strive for a large-scale program showcasing all North American living history units portraying the 1812 era.

The Sackets Harbor community last hosted a Grand Tactical in 2010; it was

selected as the site for the 2024 event because of its historic battlegrounds and ranking by the National Park Service as one of the top War of 1812 sites in the United States.

This event is supported by the Sackets Harbor Battlefield State Historic Site; the NYS Office of Parks, Recreation & Historic Preservation Bureau of Historic Sites; the Sackets Harbor Battlefield Alliance; and the War of 1812 Crown Forces North American and US Military and Naval Commands.

The War of 1812: A Brief Timeline

1808: US troops are stationed at Sackets Harbor to stop smuggling into Canada, which violates the US Embargo Act of 1807.

1810: The brig Oneida, built at Oswego, is sent to Sackets Harbor to patrol Lake Ontario and enforce US embargoes, which forbid trade with Canada.

1812: The US declares war on Great Britain. Sackets Harbor becomes headquarters for the US military on the northern frontier. The Canadian Provincial Marine Fleet attacks Sackets Harbor on July 19, 1812 but was repulsed by the USS Oneida and a long 32-pound cannon mounted on shore.

1813: Several forays into Canada are mounted from Sackets Harbor, including an attack on York (Toronto) on April 27th, which results in an American victory but the death of Brigadier General Zebulon M. Pike; and the invasion of Canada, ending in an American defeat.

British and Canadian Forces attack Sackets Harbor on May 29th and are repulsed by U.S. troops after a lengthy battle. The British and Canadians retreat but U.S. supplies are destroyed, delaying America's war efforts.


1814: Supply boats from NYC, which carry guns and supplies for the USS Superior are halted near Sandy Creek by the British. American troops ambush the British at Sandy Creek and succeed in transporting the supplies overland to Sackets Harbor, allowing the Superior to be launched.

The US and Great Britain sign a peace treaty in Ghent, Belgium on Christmas Eve, 1814. Terms of the treaty call for peace without territorial concessions from either side, and disposal of most of the armaments and ships amassed during the war.

1815: US Congress ratifies the peace treaty on Feb 16th. When word reaches Sackets Harbor, work stops on two ships under construction, the New Orleans and the Chippewa.

AN EXPANDED MILITARY INSTALLATION

Following the War of 1812, the US military presence in Sackets Harbor continued until World War II




Fort Pike

Fort Pike is located in Madison Barracks on a bluff overlooking the entrance to the harbor. Originally named Fort Volunteer, it was built in 1813 to defend Sackets Harbor from the British during the War of 1812.

Following the first Battle of Sackets Harbor that same year, the fort was rebuilt and renamed Fort Pike in honor of General Zebulon Pike, who died leading an attack from Sackets Harbor on York (now Toronto, Ontario).

Originally, the fort consisted of earthworks, a stockade wall, and a variety of artillery pieces. It served as the northern anchor for a defensive ring of fortifications that eventually surrounded Sackets Harbor.

The earthworks at Fort Pike are the only visible remains of these fortifications today. Fort Pike is now owned by the Village of Sackets Harbor, which has improved the site and converted it to a park with a trail, interpretive signage, and an observation deck.



Madison Barracks

Acclaimed as a living history museum of military architecture from post-War of 1812 through World War II, Madison Barracks played a role in every war involving our nation.

Construction began in 1816. Realizing the importance of stationed, trained troops, the US Army built Madison Barracks as one of the first planned military posts in the country.

Built at a then-substantial cost of \$85,000, the post was named for President James Madison and served as a critical link in the nation's defenses.

Throughout its existence, Madison Barracks was continually enlarged and improved to accommodate the military's needs. It was operated by the US Army until World War II. A number of well-known leaders were associated with Madison Barracks, including General Jacob Brown, President Ulysses S. Grant, NYC Mayor Fiorello LaGuardia, General Mark Clark, and General "Hap" Arnold.

Now part of the National Register of Historic Places, Madison Barracks has been reborn as a vibrant part of the Sackets Harbor community—both residentially and commercially.



Outdoor Recreation


Market Square Park is located in the heart of the village, across from the Visitor Center, where the Sentinel Bandstand overlooks the harbor. In 2023, the area was renovated and improved as part of a \$4.9 million project, funded by state and federal grants.

You'll find a lovely spot for a picnic or to take a break from shopping and touring the sites at any one of the Village's seven public parks. You can also enjoy the beauty of the changing seasons, as autumn's crisp air reveals vibrant red, orange, and yellow colors along our leafy streets.

History & 1812 Bicentennial Trails

For a short walk with a bit of education, try the **Battlefield's History Trail**. At just under one mile, this level, ADA-accessible trail will help you get your steps in for the day while also teaching you about Sackets Harbor's role in the War of 1812 and the Battlefield Site's history. You'll pass by the Lieutenant's and Commandant's Houses, the historic Navy Yard, the 1913 Centennial Monument, with historic fortifications and cannons still visible on the Battlefield today.

For a longer hike, take on some or all of the village's six-mile plus **1812 Bicentennial Trail**. Also ADA-accessible, this trail branches off from the History Trail and encompasses more of the Sackets Harbor Battlefield, Sackets Harbor Central School and athletic fields, the Old Stone Chapel, and the Military Cemetery. Along the way, you'll see more monuments and historic markers, plus fields, wooded areas, and neighborhoods. You may also spot rabbits, deer, woodchucks, porcupines, and squirrels, plus a variety of birds.

Both trails are open year-round for walking, bicycling, cross-country skiing, and snowshoeing. Maps are available from the Battlefield, the Visitor Center, and online at: https://VisitSacketsHarbor.com.

Boating, Fishing, Kayaking, and More...

Sackets Harbor is a water recreation playground, where you can enjoy fishing, sailing, swimming, kayaking, paddleboarding, and more.

There's no better way to experience the beauty of Lake Ontario than by boat. The village makes it easy to get your boat in the water with our marinas, as well as our newly improved public boat launch and docks in front of the Sentinel Bandstand.

Home to a variety of fish species, including smallmouth bass, largemouth bass, and lake trout, the harbor is the choice destination for many fishermen.

And a frozen lake doesn't mean the fishing season is over—once the open water has turned to ice, Black River Bay and Henderson Bay are prime ice fishing sites for the winter season.

Our sheltered location on Lake Ontario makes this a great area for peaceful, scenic kayak voyages. Water enthusiasts can also find recreational opportunities along the Black River for more exhilarating adventures, including nearby river rafting.

State Parks and Beaches

Westcott Beach & Park

Westcott Beach State Park is a favorite beach and campground, just minutes from downtown Sackets Harbor.

The park occupies more than 300 acres and features a boat launch, camp sites, picnic facilities, playground, swimming areas, scenic overlook, and trails for hiking, skiing, and snowshoeing.

Southwick Beach & Park

Located just 15 miles from Sackets Harbor, Southwick Beach State Park is the perfect family-friendly location for a day of swimming, boating, fishing, and hiking, or a weekend camping trip.

Visitors can enjoy 3,500 feet of lakefront and amazing views. In addition, Southwick features a playground, concessions, BBQ grills, tent and RV sites. The park also offers nature trails for hiking during the summer and snowshoeing and crosscountry skiing in the winter.




Sprawling Robert G. Wehle State Park is one of the newest in the New York Parks system, and it's just a 20-minute drive from Sackets Harbor.





Explore Our Village Attractions

The best place to begin your visit is the **Sackets Harbor Heritage Area Visitor Center**. Located in the home of village founder Augustus Sacket, the Visitor Center overlooks Market Square Park, the Sentinel Bandstand, and the waterfront. The house was built in 1801 in the Federal/Georgian style, and it was renovated and reopened as the Visitor Center in 1995. Sackets Harbor was one of the original community participants in New York State's Heritage Area Program, which supports the rehabilitation of communities through historic preservation, recreation, and education. Currently, the Visitor Center features free exhibits highlighting local history, key sites and architectural features, and the story of the village. Additionally, you'll find travel and tourism information for Sackets Harbor and the Thousand Islands and North Country regions. The Visitor Center is located at 301 West Main St and is open from May through October and for special events in the off-season.

The Pickering-Beach Museum depicts life in Sackets Harbor in the mid-1800s. It's located in a house built in 1818 by Joshua Pickering, who was a naval and commercial shipbuilder during and after the War of 1812. The house was used by Pickering's descendants, including his granddaughter and her husband, Lt. Governor Allen Beach, as a residence and summer home until 1941. It was then bequeathed to the Village of Sackets Harbor and opened to the public as a museum. Today, it houses an extensive collection of items from the Pickering-Beach family, as a well as items donated by the public. The Museum is located at 501 West Main St, next to the Battlefield, and it's open for tours during the summer months. Admission is free, and donations are welcome.

The Sackets Harbor Historical Society offices are housed in the wing of an 1834 limestone building, located at 100 West Main St. One of the most distinctive and unusual buildings of its day, it was originally the Sackets Harbor Bank and is now our local branch of Watertown Savings Bank. The Historical Society strives to stimulate community revitalization through preservation while also promoting the history of the area.

As you explore Sackets Harbor, you may hear the bells of the United Presbyterian Church marking the hours or in an impromptu summer concert. Nearby, the Old Stone Chapel, built in 1823, is celebrating its bicentennial this year. Finally, be sure to notice the numerous historical marker signs and interpretive panels throughout the village. They tell the story of some of our most famous residents and the details of pivotal events that shaped our history. You can find out more information through the Historical Marker Database at HMdb.org.

Honoring Our Veterans

The 1913 Centennial Monument at the Battlefield stands in memory of the soldiers who served in the area during the War of 1812.

Madison Barracks holds the remains of War of 1812 soldiers and memorials for veterans of other conflicts. The memorials are located near the Stone Water Tower on Brady Road and on Backus Road.

The Military Cemetery, off Dodge Avenue, is the final resting place of veterans from the Revolutionary War to modern-day conflicts. Most notably, it is the grave site of General Zebulon Pike, for whom Pike's Peak was named.

Lakeside Cemetery is a good destination for genealogists and history buffs. Located between Military Road and Dodge Avenue, the cemetery holds the remains of some of our earliest settlers. including Augustus Sacket, Elisha Camp, and Samuel F. Hooker.

Within the Town of Hounsfield, Muskalonge Cemetery's Revolutionary War era stones, along with those at Sulphur Springs Cemetery and Field Settlement Cemetery, offer a standing record of Early American families, sailors, and soldiers.

The Alexander Corners Veterans and Pearl Harbor Memorial

honors all who have served. Located on NYS Route 3 in Henderson, the Memorial was started in 1996 with the placement of a M60A3 Main Battle Tank and was expanded in 2002 with the addition of a Cobra Helicopter. The Memorial features beautiful gardens and was originally part of the farm of Revolutionary War veteran. Oliver Bates. whose home is on the NYS and National Register of Historic Sites.






