Scarecrow & Skeleton Contest

SIGN-UP:

The contest is open to Sackets Harbor residents, organizations, and businesses. One entry per household, organization or business. Sign up before 4:00 pm on October 21, 2023. No late entries accepted! You will be assigned a number and spot on W Main Street with your confirmation of entry.

CONSTRUCTION:

- Entries must be moveable (35 lbs or less) and must be between 4 feet to 6 feet tall. Bases not to exceed a three-foot square. They must be self-supporting and weatherproof.
- All decorations must be firmly attached to the scarecrow/skeleton.
- No separate props. Electrical access is only available in select locations; please request in advance.
- All entries must be hand-made. No perishable goods (except for pumpkins and gourds), glass, sharp parts or liquids may be used in construction or display.

ENTRIES:

- All entries must be installed on W Main Street on October 25, 2023, in their designated spot. Entries will be on display from October 25 to November 7, 2023. The Event Committee is not liable for any loss or damage.
- Please pick up entries on November 7, 2023, by 5:00 pm. After this time, any entries remaining will become property of the Sackets Harbor Chamber of Commerce and disposed of accordingly.
- HalloweenVille is a family-friendly event. Entries should be whimsical, humorous, mischievous or loveable. Gruesome, bloody or especially scary entries will be disqualified and removed by the Event Committee.
- No advertising, defamatory content, or political statements are permitted.

VOTING:

- Entries will be judged by local judges.
- People's Choice voting will be conducted by visitors during HalloweenVille, October 28th, noon to 4 pm. Ballots will be available at the admission tables. All ballots must be in designated boxes by 4:30 pm on Saturday, October 28, 2023.
- Winners will be announced on November 1, 2023. Winners will be contacted by phone or email.
